Wojciech Jakóbczyk has over 18 years of experience in developing software for business customers from all over the world. He has worked in both global corporations as well as young, dynamic companies in the new technologies sector.

Most recently Wojciech was Head of Engineering at TV & Devices Department at Opera Software. He was responsible for the development of new products supplied to home electronics market leaders and telecommunications operators; each year these products go to the tens millions of customers around the world.

Wojciech is a graduate of the Faculty of Informatics and Management, Technical University of Wrocław. At PiLab Wojciech is responsible for product development, process improvement and expansion of the Engineering organization.

Wojciech started his career in the second half of the 1990s in the computer gaming industry. He co-created the strategy game "Clash", which was sold in multiple countries.

Wojciech co-created pioneering websites such as Autointernet (www.autointernet.pl - one of the first commercial automotive websites run by the Polish Finance Company) as well as internal services for telecommunications and financial companies. Wojciech also developed Probit, a multi-layered architecture ERP system for SMEs.

At **Siemens VDO** (now part of Trapeze Group) he helped develop an innovative architecture for a public transport control system.

Since 2008 Wojciech has had managerial positions in Opera Software. Opera is a global high-tech software company with revenues of \$480M USD (2014) and over 1000 employees, listed on the Oslo Stock Exchange:

- In the TV & Devices Department Wojciech was responsible for the development and implementation of new products supplied to home electronics market leaders and telecommunications operators. Each year these products go to tens of millions of customers around the world.

- Since 2013 Wojciech has been Head of Engineering.
- In 2013 – 2014 Wojciech was focused on leadership development and implementations of a new line of products based on open-source technology Google Chromium. These successful products generated a significant increase in revenues.
